Pacific Network Launches the Native Hawaiian Portal to the World

Award winning filmmaker Edgy Lee will present a preview of her latest project, "Pacific Network". In what has been dubbed the Native Hawaiian portal to the world, "Pacific Network Television", is being launched as Hawaii's first major Internet-based television. PacificNetwork.tv will offer a full range of free Hawaii-themed original programming on nine channels and aims at creating a global community across oceans and time zones combining the best of television, print, and the web through its news-gathering, distribution and information dissemination service. By providing an alternative to network television news and programming and stories from our greater Hawaiian community, Pacific Network will serve people and businesses based locally and overseas.

Edgy Lee is a fifth generation Hawaii-born filmmaker. Her most recent film, "The Hawaiians - Reflecting Spirit", was presented at the opening of the Smithsonian Institution Museum of the American Indian in Washington D.C., currently broadcasting on PBS. It focuses on understanding ecosystems oriented to sustainability and how the future of Hawaiians and other native cultures impacts others. Her filmography includes Papakolea, Story of Hawaiian Land (Silver Award Independent Programming, Corporation for Public Broadcasting; CINE Golden Eagle, NEM Silver Apple) Waikiki In the Wake of Dreams (New York International Independent Film & Video Festival, Best Cinematography, Best Editing) and Paniolo O Hawaii ~ Cowboys of the Far West (Chicago International Film Festival INTERCOM, Silver Plaque History and Writing award) among other works. In 2004 and 2005 Edgy produced two films on methamphetamine in unprecedented prime time simulcasts on eleven television stations through out the State of Hawaii. The Honolulu Star Bulletin named her one of Ten Most Influential citizens and she received the first Pacific Business News Non Profit Leadership Award for her work as a local documentary filmmaker. In 1999 she produced a CD with His Holiness the 14th Dalai Lama, a compilation of traditional Tibetan music performed by artists living in exile around the world. As an in-studio record producer, she worked with the late, famed Jamaican "Godfather of Reggae" Joe Higgs, The Wailers, and other artists. She has composed music with jazz legend Wayne Shorter; film composer, Joseph Vitarelli; and this year one of her compositions will be performed by Brazilian artist, Ivan Lins. Edgy's latest project is the creation of the Pacific Network, an Internet network of nine channels designed as a Native Hawaiian portal to the world, a nexus for news, entertainment, educational and interactive programs.
